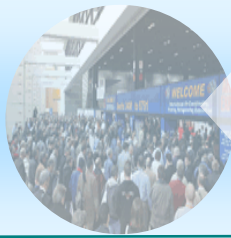
CRCs are held annually to bring representatives from each Chapter together to discuss Chapter operations and provide an opportunity to meet fellow ASHRAE members from other Chapters.
