William J. Coad is president of Coad Engineering Enterprises in St. Louis, Missouri. Mr. Coad is a registered professional engineer in 37 states, was the president of ASHRAE in 2001-2002 and has served extensively on ASHRAE committees and councils.

He has received numerous awards for his engineering achievements including ASHRAE Fellow, Louise and Bill Holliday distinguished Fellow Award, and the F. Paul Anderson Award, the Donald Julius Groen Prize of the British Institute of Mechanical Engineers and the Alumni Achievement Award of Washington University.

Distinguished Speaker's Topic

Mr. Coad delivered a spectacular presentation regarding "The Ethics and the economics of Energy Conservation"

His talk explored the economics of energy conservation and the failure of economic alternatives in the search for more energy conservative buildings and machines.

Based upon this observation, an alternative perspective leads to the conclusion that energy conservation is an ethic and if this ethic is embraced by those who practice in the energy sciences, the inevitable result will be improved system performance, energy conservation and economics.

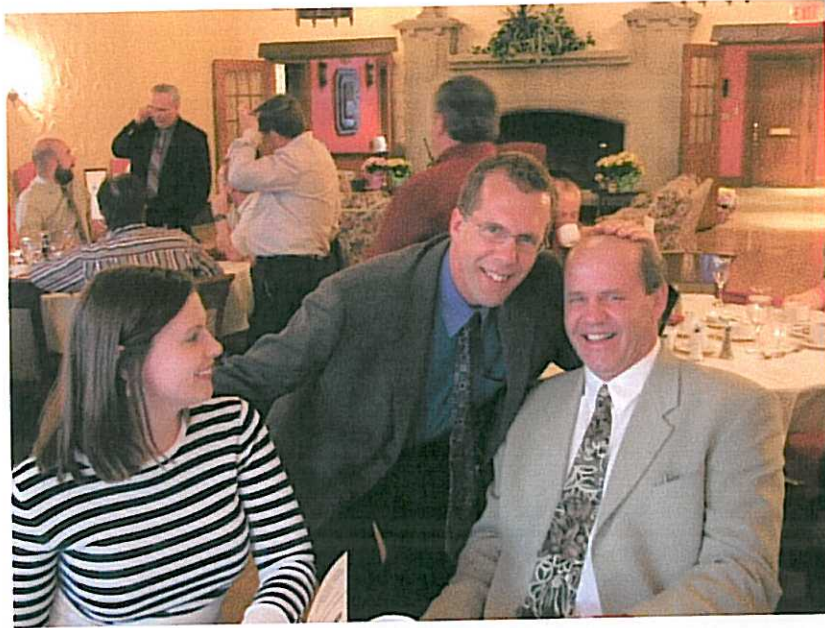

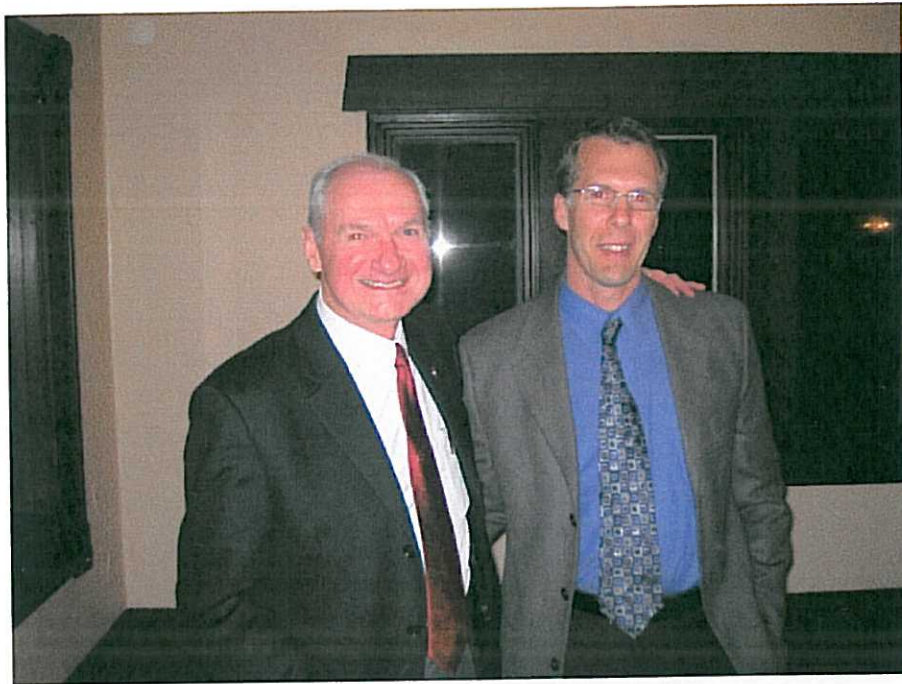

At the conclusion of the presentations, Chapter President Bill Davies brought the meeting to a close.

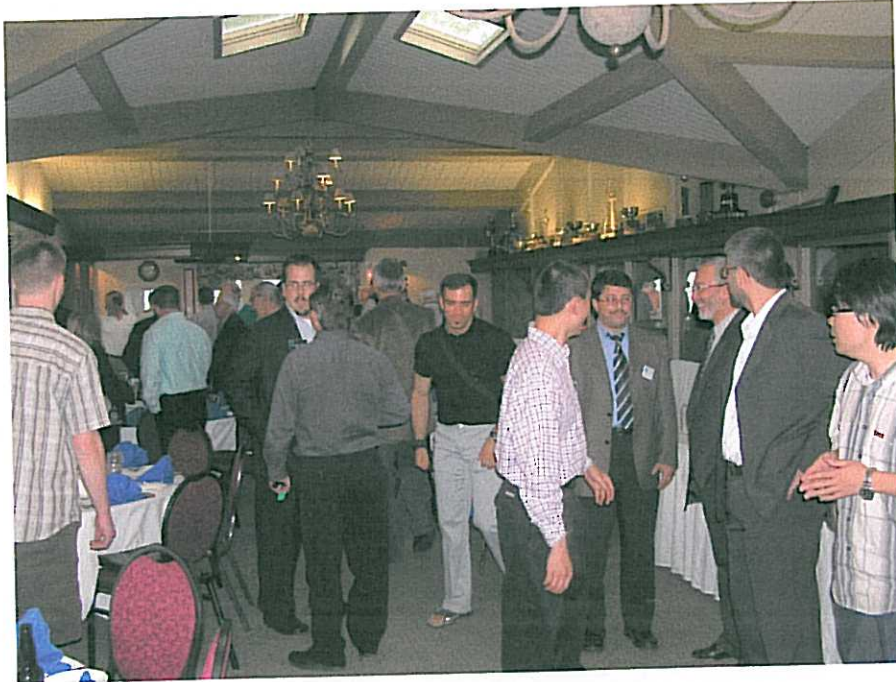

The presenter is **Barry Benator, P.E.**, **President of BENATECH, INC.**, a leadership and management consulting firm specializing in services to the design and construction field. Barry has a Masters degree in Electrical Engineering and more than 25 years experience in the engineering field.

He has conducted leadership and management programs for ASHRAE, AEE, Chevron Energy Solutions and other professional societies and engineering firms. 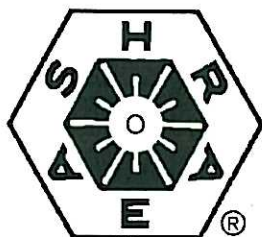

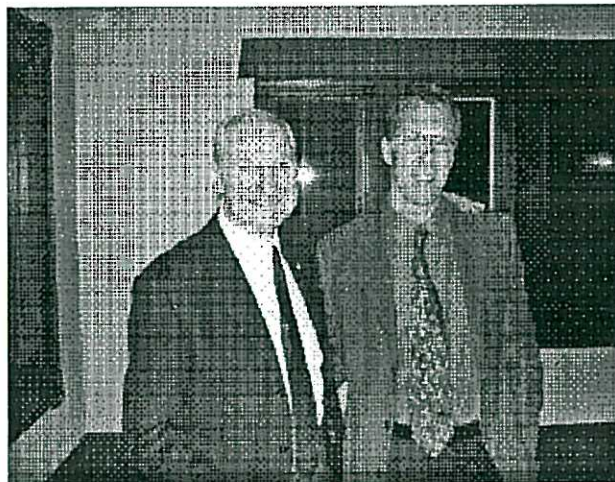
