

The presentation will be on one of the sustainable energy savings initiatives of the building. The building hollow core slabs given their intrinsic ability to store and distribute heating and cooling in any climate. panels are naturally able to retain heat and cool energy (a process known as "thermal storage") to be released upon demand. From a technical perspective, the process of thermal storage that occurs via floors and ceilings works intuitively with fan-assisted ventilation that pushes the fresh air through a series of main ducts that are fed into smaller branch ducts, strategically placed within the larger hollow core slab structure. As air passes through the ducts, the concrete warms or cools the fresh air before supplying it to the occupied space.
